

Wind Information Needed to Apply

Please note that **this is NOT an application** for PA AEPS certification, the application must be completed online at <https://pennaeps.com/>

1. Installation Address

2. Online Date (Date System Energized)

This is the date your system was turned on, left on for operation, and began continuously tracking production. Note that the date entered is in Year-Month-Day. If your system was turned online prior to the year 2014, you must type the year in manually.

3. Interconnection Approval Date

This must match the date on the form you upload in Step 4.

4. Wind Turbine Manufacturer

5. Turbine Power Rating (AC Watts)

6. Turbine Model #

7. Number of Turbines

8. Turbine Location

9. Turbine Hub Height (ft)

10. Rotor Diameter

11. Total System Size (AC Watts)

12. Total System Rated Output (AC Watts)

13. Total Estimated Annual Production (kWh)

14. System Photo(s) *For wind farms, please provide a representative photo of several installed turbines at the site.*

15. A Certificate of Completion (CoC), or Permission to Operate (PTO) document, or other utility issued document confirming commercial operating date is required for all systems. *This will contain the date that the utility granted final approval to operate the system.*

16. If an application is submitted more than 30 days after utility interconnection approval is issued, a meter photo is required. *This may be taken from a system-dedicated meter showing the reading or from an online monitoring portal, if applicable. Photos from bi-directional meters are not allowed for verification purposes as they reflect the combined production and net of a system.*

17. If you have selected an aggregator to manage your system, either a Recognition of Assignment (ROA) or a Schedule A is required. *An ROA is required for leased/PPA systems while a Schedule A is required for non-leased/PPA aggregated systems. Please thoroughly review the document and ensure that all required signatures are present.*

18. NPDES permit, Notice of Termination, or NPDES equivalent
